IMA BENDER BOO stalked along the inside pressing to even terms in upper stretch, responded in drive shaking off DENTON SINGS RUBY to clear late. WAKKI GOLD slow early rallied from mid track in upper stretch surging late for place. DENTON SINGS RUBY laid close up pressing to even terms abreast rivals in upper stretch, extended dueling with IMA BENDER BOO would waver late. STORMY ENGAGEMENT sent clear was hustled on pace through the turn, hooked between horses in upper stretch would wear to pressure. JETTA PAIGE slow early gave a mild rally to upper stretch then finished evenly. SCALD slow early gave a modest move to upper stretch failing to menace. DANCING PHOENIX played no factor. STORMING CARSON gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. ONECO was always outrun.
