KWAME saved ground through the far turn swinging out six wide in upper stretch, took aim at LIVELY EXIT using full extension to get up on the wire. LIVELY EXIT unhurried early advanced from the half surging to go clear three wide in upper stretch, seeing KWAME looming would angle out giving all late to no avail. WHOSGOTTHEJOHNNIE stalked the pace staying close threatening four wide into upper stretch, wavered under a drive dropping off the leaders while holding position. OK BAY alert to the top set the pace through the far turn then gave way in upper stretch. CHIEF WINDSONG sat close up saving ground chasing OK BAY through the far turn, cut the corner to upper stretch fading there along the rail. DUBAI CITY wide early was always outrun. CRYPTEEZE lost ground tiring after half a mile. ACTIVATOR wide early folded up after a half.
