HIGH SILVER sent for the early lead, went clear racing into the backstretch, allowed to rate along on soft splits to the 3/8 pole, felt pressure nearing the 1/4 pole, cut loose there, responded taking charge in upper stretch, held sway to wire. LEGENDARY QUEEN unhurried off the early pace, angled out 4 wide and crept closer into final turn, pursued HIGH SILVER into the stretch, was no match there, went full out abreast J B'S VICTORIA to secure place. J B'S VICTORIA well placed into the opening turn, tracked HIGH SILVER on a slow pace to the 1/2 mile pole, roused to leader along the inside on turn, chased inside in drive gradually wearing down. PROMISED TOUR raced evenly off the pace, roused for move from the 1/2 mile pole, had no surge in drive. TIPPING outrun early on, saved ground in second flight, wavered near the 1/4 pole, little left stretch. LIL BONIT sent inside, chased HIGH SILVER to the 1/2 mile pole, wilted into final turn. PRIZE RUNNER was always outrun.
