Footnotes

STOLEN WATERS hustled along the rail to press for the lead going into the far turn, vied in a three way duel mid turn, edged away under strong handling from mid stretch, won driving. AL FAASIL lacked speed despite being urged going down the backside, gained momentum leaving the quarter pole, angled to split rivals in mid stretch, dueled for minor awards and got the place position late in a game effort. FLORENCIO unhurried early, saved ground throughout, rallied to loom mid stretch, failed to sustain bid and was out finished coming to the wire. LORD ABOVE showed good speed, vied early racing four wide, battled to mid stretch, weakened late. FLECK OF GOLD rated early, launched bid coming five wide into the lane, needed more, finished evenly. TOUGH TO BE HUMBLE hustled to show brief foot, dropped off some on the bend, never menaced. FAST FREDDIE lacked speed, raced wide throughout, slightly improved placing but was no factor. TRACKSIDE TOMMY was outrun early, raced mid track, never involved. DONNA'S BLACKJACK sent hard, vied to the quarter pole, raced between foes entering the stretch, was all done giving way at the eighth pole, used up.
