ON TOUR unhurried off the inside emerged to threaten inside the eighth pole, ran at GINGERS LADD from mid track getting up on the wire. GINGERS LADD broke alertly nursing a short lead along the inside to upper stretch, widened the margin late in the two path only to be grabbed in the final strides. SIDEWINDER stalked close up looming along the inside to upper stretch, extended in the three path lacked a closing punch. SERVICE ACT laid close up skimming the rail while pressing GINGERS LADD to upper stretch, extended late would hang. A STAR FOR JESSIE chased the early pace dropping off in somewhat close quarters entering the turn, continued along the inside giving even action the final eighth. MULTIPHONE slow early raced four wide through the lane improving modestly. T QUE raced second flight playing no factor. FUNKY COUNTRY raced evenly off the pace fading six wide through the stretch. MASCARON raced five wide on the turn, was always outrun.
