NATRONA laid close up, faded off leaders turn, bid top lane, evenly late. MISS SPAIN made early lead, collared on turn, extended in drive, weakened. DAVES BABY stumbled at start, wide stretch. GOLD CROSS hustled to front, chased dueling rivals, tired. CHARMING SKIER stumbled at start. APPEALING WIND brief foot, faded off. ISLE OF TUNES dropped back, outrun. ALICE IN WONDER brief foot, gave way.
