**Footnotes**

ISLAND BREEZE was well rated racing in the two path to the far turn, hooked NAKED PASSION into upper stretch angling out while abreast rival drawing off late. NAKED PASSION broke alert making the early lead, saved ground posting soft fractions to the far turn, collared along the rail by ISLAND BREEZE in upper stretch proved no match holding as a clear second best. VENUS DRIVE prompted a slow pace through the backside, lost contact with the top pair racing four wide into upper stretch, had even action there to hold the others safe. GLIDING PRINCESS saved ground in the two path to the far turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch finishing evenly, bled. CASEY'S GIRL saved ground dropping from contention in upper stretch. CHELSEYS FAN stalked the pace three wide to the half, flattened out into upper stretch. SHEBA'S DREAM was always outrun racing six wide through the stretch.
