CITY CODE tracked evenly through the turn, surged abreast rival down the lane, edged clear driving. CAST NO SHADOW slow early, came wide to upper stretch, rallied late on the outside. ULLTIMATE GOLD hustled up early, bid clear on the turn, extended through the lane, faltered. BROKE US slow early, varied little on the turn, found belated stride. DEPUTY DIRECTOR squeezed back at the break, came on after the fact. DROP SHOT (ARG) a step slow early, played no factor. MIGHTY FORTRESS veered out at the break, hustled along, tired. MR. PRESLEY squeezed back at the break, labored. EGO'S APPEAL sent clear, passed on the turn, gave way. CLASSIC ACRE chased early, weakened on the turn, gave way.
