LOOKOFANEAGLE raced up close from the start stalking a contested pace, bid four wide to join the fray at the quarter pole, drew clear mid stretch, held firm under steady pressure. CHIEF WINDSONG was well placed tracking the pace along the rail, angled four wide top of the stretch taking aim on LOOKOFANEAGLE, closed the gap in deep stretch finishing willingly. PARKER VALLEY unhurried early, angled out in upper stretch, split rivals with a furlong to go, finished strongly. BENGAL LORE sent hard from the gate, angled to the rail, dueled around the bend, vied in three way battle leaving the quarter pole, brushed a couple of times with RING READY in the drive, tired late from earlier efforts. KISS MY CASH was outrun to the quarter pole, came out six wide into the lane, found best stride too late, finished with interest but was no menace. RING READY hard used early, dueled with BENGAL LORE soon after the start, vied in three way duel near the quarter pole racing between foes, brushed a couple of times with BENGAL LORE mid stretch, weakened late. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed, raced wide into the lane, never threatened. TROOPER THORN tracked along the rail, put to a drive, failed to respond, no factor. DANNY BANANNIE broke a bit outward, hustled up to track the pace, urged mid turn, failed to respond and gave way mid stretch. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS CONDUCTED CONCERNING THE STRETCH RUN, AFTER REVIEW, THE RESULTS STOOD AS IS.
