AMBER DUBAI dropped back early trailing through the turn, swung out seven wide in upper stretch responded surging up in the last strides. STORMY DUDE sent hard wrested then worked on a short lead through the turn, digging in at the head of the lane dropped from the two path to the rail being hooked late just missing. JOT EM DOWN went evenly gaining a bit on the turn, extending in upper stretch bore out sharply under left hand urging to the six path while closing in late. MAD AFTERSHOCK stalked the pace staying in range through the turn, bidding near mid track in upper stretch was carried out by AMBER DUBAI late finishing in close quarters between horses. SMOOTH TOWN pressured the pace through the turn, wavered in upper stretch bearing out eight wide late. MATTY'S EQUALIZER slow early drew a bit closer on the turn, steadied off a drifting SMOOTH TOWN in upper stretch folding up after. AWESOME IN BLACK away slowly was hustled along four wide through the turn, would flatten out in upper stretch. A stewards inquiry into the stretch run resulted in no change.
