Footnotes

FULL HORSE POWER stalked FORCRYINOUTLOUD soon after the start, set down leaving the quarter pole, came four wide from upper stretch, slowly wore down that rival to arrive in time for a hard earned victory. FORCRYINOUTLOUD sent early, cleared into the far turn, raced ion the three path turning for home, fought hard under a stiff from mid stretch, wore down coming to the finish line missing in a game effort. SIX MILLER'S tracked early while saving ground, angled out five wide top of the lane, chased top pair to the wire needing more while besting rest. LAGOON was outrun to the quarter pole racing mid track, angled out six wide mid stretch, showed belated interest improving placing but failed to menace. PLEASANT MAN pressed the runner up briefly, stalked from mid turn, lacked rally and faded from mid stretch. J'S KING'S RANSOM made alight bobble as the gate opened, quickly recovered and raced wide throughout, gave way top of the stretch. SHINY SHIELD lacked speed, faded from mid turn, no factor.
