SLEW OF MEDALS broke alertly measuring on lead through the backside, began to take charge on the far turn moving clear into upper stretch holding firm in the two path. ALBANY INDIAN settled early stayed back to the half, circling out on the far turn came six wide in upper stretch angling in a bit late while getting up for place. ELLE SPECIAL tracked the pace edging closer on the backside, chased SLEW OF MEDALS into upper stretch extending in the three path hanging late. SWEET TIA slow early raced evenly on the backside angling four wide to upper stretch, lacked surge while holding position. LINDA'S CANDY broke slowly being outrun to the far turn, swung out six wide in upper stretch had modest improvement. SISTER GERTRUDE settled early gave a steady middle move threatening near the half, chasing on the far turn would waver leveling off in upper stretch near the rail. QUITE SASSY stayed back throughout. VENUS DRIVE close up early would fade on the backside.
