Footnotes

BEAR'S CONDUCTOR slow early saved ground firing into upper stretch edging up along the rail. LONG RANGE MISSILE broke sharply pressing the pace through turn dueling between horses upper stretch, ceding to inside pressure holding for place in the three path. FOURTH TOP chased close up looming a threat four deep upper stretch, extending late would hang near the wire. DYNAMIC DINO sent hard pressed to put a head in front upper stretch, would weaken late in the two path. FLIP FLOP in tight nearing the turn came out impeding LAZY NATHAN causing that one to clip heels with BALTIMORE RAVEN, angled five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. LAZY NATHAN crowded by FLIP FLOP near the three eighths pole came out clipping heels with BALTIMORE RAVEN causing that one to stumble and lose his rider. CAT AND CUSTARD pressed early then gave way while drifting out seven wide in upper stretch. HENRY STREET struggled throughout. BALTIMORE RAVEN clipped heels near the three eighths pole stumbling badly losing the rider in the process. appeared fine when walking off after the race. A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT NEAR THE THREE EIGHTHS POLE RESULTED IN FLIP FLOP BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED EIGHTH AND LAZY NATHAN BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED NINTH.
