Footnotes

SIRR PURR slow early rallied on the inside upper stretch, angled out finding room between horses late getting up gamely. MR. BOURBON STREET a step slow rallied six wide out of the turn, angled in vying gamely abreast three deep late. CASSIUS CASEY broke alertly wresting then clinging to a short lead through the turn, collared in the two path upper stretch gave more battling to the end. MARKET TUMBLE hustled outside pressed up to challenge on the turn, extended at mid track down the lane came up a bit short. MAJOR STRIKE chased along the inside, pressed from the rail upper stretch before weakening late. TREKKIE angled out into the turn, came in close quarters steadying briefly into upper stretch, finished evenly in the six path. CAST NO SHADOW hustled along on the outside weakened eight wide down the stretch. PRINCEOFTHESTORMYC slow early rushed up to bid four deep on the turn then leveled off quickly in upper stretch. I'M ALL IN was always outrun racing seven wide upper stretch. GREY MIRAGE labored well back.
