HOPE RESTORED raced up close while in hand down the backside racing three wide, moved mid turn and headed MERIDA CITY, duelled to top of the stretch, drew off under energetic handling and continued to widen to the finish line. BIG DEBBIE rated from the gate, sat patient traveling off the rail in the second flight, launched rally coming four wide entering the stretch, finished willingly picking up second place but never threatened the winner. MERIDA CITY pressed for the early lead, edged clear at the half, was soon headed by the winner, battled to top of the stretch, gave way at the eighth pole and was under a drive to save third place late. LETS SNEAK IN was forwardly placed racing along the rail going to the half, angled out giving chase at the quarter pole, swung five wide upper stretch, lacked response besting rest. ARIMATHEA lagged off the pace for six furlongs, passed a couple of fading rivals in the lane improving position but never factored. ALISSA WHO raced four wide into the first turn, remained well off the rail throughout racing towards the rear, offered little. TOPPER'S TALE was hard used vying for the early lead, battled to the half, retreated from midway on the second turn, finished spent.
