THE ALCOVA KID slow under early prompting saved ground into the far turn, circled out into upper stretch firing at mid track sweeping up in the closing yards. SMOKY KNIGHT was well rated in the three path, swung out five wide on the far turn surged into upper stretch wresting a narrow lead, extended late could not hold to outside pressure. LUHUKATMEGO saved ground firing into the far turn, led along the rail dueling into upper stretch, ceded to SMOKEY KNIGHT then wore down late. CANALI slow early would save ground to the far turn, swung out six wide in upper stretch mustered a mild rally to improve position late. HAJJI'S HONOR wide into the opening turn would race five deep, vying hard through the far turn into upper stretch moved six wide late wearing down. WILD PURSUIT was angled inside on the backstretch, threatening on the far turn raced behind a wall of horses though never checking, continued saving ground to upper stretch finishing up evenly. FIDDLERS JINGO sent clear set an inside pace through the backside, collared between horses on the far turn would cede to upper stretch wilting late. PLEASANT COMPANY lost ground throughout laboring home eight wide. YOUNG DOM four wide to the backside stalked then challenged for the lead on the far turn, began to waver in upper stretch giving way late.
