**Footnotes**

LIL GREAT TOUCH a step slow through the turn found stride in the six path upper stretch surging quickly to go by in the final strides. THE KAVORKA broke alertly pressuring the pace abreast SPEEDY GRAHAM through the turn, battled in the three path down the lane holding well while being overpowered in the last yards. SPEEDY GRAHAM sent hard pressed the pace from between horses through the turn, continued to duel from the two path down the lane giving all to the end. CHUY'S CHOICE slow early raced three path to upper stretch, angled out to mid track picked up position late. BROKEN POST chased close up through the turn, extending into upper stretch wore down in the four path. ONE BLUE SKY played no factor finishing six wide. ZACH'S SUNRISE slow early finished along the rail. FLASHINTHEMEADOW pressured the pace along the inside through the turn then wilted down the stretch. CARRIBEAN CALLING was always outrun racing seven wide down the lane. THE RAG MAN raced second flight folding up at mid track upper stretch.
