QUEBELICK well rated at mid pack, followed the pace waiting to move, cut loose on the far turn, angled out to mid track taking aim at BIRD CHATTER, went fully extended abreast rival, crowded by drifting foe in last strides prevailing fully extended. BIRD CHATTER sent to go close up to the backstretch, prompted outside of SHE'SBUBBA'SDELITE posting soft fractions to the far turn, roused to wrest a short lead in mid drive, collared from the outside by QUEBELICK a 1/16 out, dueled in tandem, drifted out crowding rival near the wire, missed gamely. CLASSIC BONNIE away slowly, taken 5 wide once reaching the backside, edged to leaders looming 6 wide into upper stretch, continued to respond willingly chasing to wire. SHE'SBUBBA'SDELITE sent up for the early pace, pressed a soft pace racing along the inside, dueled briskly with BIRD CHATTER to mid stretch, came up a little short in drive. BOUBLITCHKY taken in hand going restrained to the backside, roused to edge up near the 1/2, chased under hard prompting on the far turn, failed to threaten leveling off through the lane. DUAL DOPPLER raced evenly in second flight, never mounted a credible bid. SEATTLE THEME sent up to early contention, faded off outside the 1/4 pole, empty into stretch. PROMISED TOUR was hustled along losing ground, wilted after a 1/2 mile.
