Footnotes

WHITE OAK well placed off a hurried pace, loomed while angling out on the turn, fired 4 wide at the 1/4 pole, swept to the top in upper stretch, edged away driving. DINNER GHOST hustled out pressing on pace to the turn, backed off a duel stalking to the head of the lane, angled out at the 1/8 pole, gave steady surge to secure place. HAIL DEVONGATE dropped well back early, labored along through the turn, came 4 wide into stretch, found stride finishing with interest. NO MORE TAX sent hard engaging MISS STORMY on the pace, battled abreast rival through the turn, extended along the inside in upper stretch, wore down in drive. MISS STORMY broke sharply to contest the pace, dueled on the inside of NO MORE TAX through the turn, asked for more in upper stretch, folded up near the rail late. WAGON RIDE bumped with COOLRIDGE MIA at the break, was hustled off the pace, made a limited move into upper stretch, flattened out the final 1/16. GOLD BABY GOLD was always outrun. COOLRIDGE MIA bumped with WAGON RIDE at the break, raced on rail struggling throughout. MS. FOOLISH DANCER dropped well back early, was pulled up on the turn and vanned off after the race.
