DUSTY CAT stalked pace, roused on turn, surged in drive, up driving. TOO MANY CHOICES tracked evenly, varied little on turn, responded in drive, gamely. POSITIVE SPIRIT broke sharply, went alert on lead, weary mid lane, ceded. JONETA pinched back start, rushed to contention, weakened. I'M DUE slow early, altered course, failed to menace. LADY LUST step slow, labored on turn, had no surge. CONCERTA dropped back, always outrun. FIN LADY pinched back start, checked spill backside, no chance. TRIPLE ARTS veered in start, clipped heels 1/2 mile pole, eased. SEIZE THE GLORY came out at start, clipped heels near 1/2 pole, broke down.
