MINEY'S AWESOME hustled out for the early lead, measured along the inside of NINE TU TU'S through the backstretch, measured that one edging away into the lane, kept drive while well clear late. SPEAK OUT well placed on the early pace, followed MINEY'S AWESOME through the backside, emerged as main threat near the 1/4 pole, remained willing under a drive while clearly second best. NINE TU TU'S sent along from the gate, pursued under a ride to the 1/2, rebuffed into final turn, began to waver near the 1/4 pole, had little left late. SOBER MOMENT away slowly, trailed the field to the 1/2 mile pole, angled out on turn, picked up tired ones in drive. DOUBTFUL DIVA raced evenly in second flight, lost ground through the backstretch, had no response when called upon. LA JOCONDE was never involved. REIMA ROSE was always a step slow seeming to dislike the surface. BRIGADOON dropped back early offering little. MILITARY MISSION hustled along racing wide for a 1/2 mile, folded up on final turn.
