BEA'S HARD SIX hustled to the top, set all the pace traveling in the two path, received strong left handed stick top of the lane, drew off being kept to task to the finish line. LADY LANNIS raced up close from the start, began to chase running three wide into the stretch, failed to threaten the winner in the lane but gamely fought hard saving second place. MAESTRO MISS broke a bit awkwardly, trailed to the far turn, advanced mid turn running four wide, battled for a minor award from upper stretch, leveled off and settled for third best. SWEET BABY JEEPERS pressed the winner down the backside, gave chase running towards the inside from upper stretch, tired late missing a minor award. O'DAPURDEEBABEE varied little despite being hard ridden, no threat. RUNZEN flashed brief foot, began to give way past the quarter pole, finished well beaten.
