**Footnotes**

SOLO CAT stalked STRAIGHT COUNT while saving ground throughout, sat patient around the bend, waited behind duelers in upper stretch, swung out five wide mid stretch, was aggressively ridden to arrive in time for the victory. SIR RABBIT staked throughout, advanced mid turn, vied entering the stretch, took a slight edge mid stretch, was run down in last jumps, missed in a game try. BIPOLAR EXPRESS stalked early on, bid mid turn, vied for the lead traveling between foes from upper stretch, was outfinished in deep stretch. STRAIGHT COUNT quickly made the lead, set all the pace running along the rail, headed leaving the quarter pole, fought to mid stretch, faded late from earlier efforts. STAY IN THE BUGGY lacked speed, was outrun throughout, did narrow the gap in the stretch but was never a factor.
