Footnotes

POCKET MEDAL rushed down the backside and dueled for the lead at the half racing between foes, edged clear mid turn, shook free entering the stretch, was hard ridden to prevail in a determined effort. RIDGE DANCE (GB) settled towards the rear, launched rally coming five to six wide upper stretch, finished strongly just getting up for second place on the wire. DUKES ALLEY tracked a contested pace traveling off the rail, rallied four wide into the lane, loomed off the winner from mid stretch, needed a bit more late and was out noddod fighting for second place. HANCHO rushed a middle move and vied in the three way battle at the half racing widest, dueled to the quarter pole with the winner, began to tire in mid stretch. MR. KEEPER well placed and saved ground throughout, failed to respond when asked, no threat in the lane. CANYON DRIVE varied little racing in the second flight, failed to menace. RULER BOY was always outrun, dull effort. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC hustled leaving the gate and angled to the rail, battled to the half in a three way duel, was all done mid turn, gave way throughout the stretch.
