Footnotes

CRYPTOLIGHT stalked close up pressing abreast SHOT OF KELA on the far turn, wrested the lead while angling in slightly upper stretch drawing out under urging in the three path. SHOT OF KELA broke alertly setting the pace on a short lead to the far turn, engaged there by CRYPTOLIGHT dueled inside of rival to upper stretch proving no match while angling out to the four path late. BLUEGRASS DREAMER in tight on the run to the opening turn pressured his entry mate through the backside then weakened on the far turn fading in the four path down the lane. DOLCE LUSSO was always outrun. SAFETY VALVE briefly close up would retreat on the backside wilting into the far turn. LOST APTITUDE done early was eased in upper stretch. An objection from the rider of SHOT OF KELA against the rider of CRYPTOLIGHT for interference at the head of the lane was dismissed by the stewards.
