IMA GIVEN pressed early then backed off SPA PRINCESS stalking on the turn, angled three then four wide down the lane edging clear under a drive. LEADER OF THE LITE slow early angled out in upper stretch, responded in the six path coming back in a bit while getting up late to salvage place. SPA PRINCESS sent hard worked to clear on the turn, extending along the inside through the stretch would weaken late in the two path. SAY JAS a step slow through the turn gave an even finish in the four path. TROPICAL UPDATE played no factor racing five and six wide down the lane. SPRINGS BLING away slowly would labor throughout. BABY ON THE GO chased early then weakened on the turn giving way to upper stretch.
