Footnotes

NOPROBLEMFOR DINO sat close up stalking KAYS CAT along the inside early, surged to draw even in a three way battle on the turn, shook clear to upper stretch taking the three path while digging in to hold off KYLE'S TREASURE late. KYLE'S TREASURE tracked a quick pace traveling four wide through the turn, took aim at NOPROBLEMFOR DINO in upper stretch first angling in under a right hand whip then out under left hand urging, couldn't get by. SIRR PURR slow early varied little on the turn, steadied briefly top stretch moving closer four wide, looming late went hand ridden from the sixteenth pole. STATELY CLOCK slow early varied little through the turn, rallied into upper stretch, loomed on the outside, hung late. BEST GAMBLE off slowly was outrun through the turn, circled five wide in upper stretch remained no menace. ALEXAGOGO slow early was swung six wide in upper stretch lacking surge. SOMERSET'S DANCER sent hard pressured rivals three wide on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. KAYS CAT stumbled at the break quickly recovering to rush to the early lead, dueled between horses on the turn wearing down in upper stretch.
