GOLD PURCHASE hustled early, dueled with LUCKY PENNIES to the quarter pole, edged clear turning for home then was headed by STEVEN'S AFLEET, repulsed that rival inside the eighth pole, drew off late under steady handling. STEVEN'S AFLEET stalked to the quarter pole, came three wide entering the stretch, almost drew even with the winner in upper stretch, was turned away a sixteenth out, settled for second best in a hard effort. TOMFOOLERY rated and moved off the rail shortly after the start, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, chased top pair under a stiff drive, needed more but won the head bob gaining third place. ROGUES HOLLOW settled in mid pack, roused coming five wide at the quarter pole, needed more in deep stretch and was outgamed vying for a minor award. S MAN bumped with CHATFIELDS CHARGE shortly after the start, trailed to the quarter pole, came five wide entering the stretch, gave action after the fact never threatening. LUCKY PENNIES sent hard and pressed the winner to the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch, used up. CHATFIELDS CHARGE bumped shortly after the start, saved ground around the bend, failed to factor. RAPID RIDERS raced evenly in the second flight, failed to menace and gave way mid stretch.
