Footnotes

STRUCTURAL broke alertly and angled towards the rail, was headed by MORE THAN A KING near the quarter pole, repulsed that rival in upper stretch, drew off being kept to task. MORE THAN A KING rushed into the far turn, almost drew even with STRUCTURAL leaving the quarter pole, was turned away by mid stretch finishing second best in a game effort. FOURTH TOP stalked top pair around the turn, angled inside upper stretch giving chase, never threatened while besting rest. DENIZEN settled early, mounted a mild bid mid turn, leveled off needing more late. MIDSHIP MAMBO hustled flashing brief foot, traveled along the rail throughout, never menaced and tired in the drive. CHAD'S GOT CLASS lacked speed and was outrun, passed two weary foes improving placing but never factored. CAT AND CUSTARD was off a step slow, raced four wide around the turn, offered little. SNEAKY DREAMS raced evenly in the second flight, began to fade from upper stretch, no factor.
