ALRIGHT NOW rushed a middle move at the half taking over as a pair of duelers were traveling well off the rail, headed by TIME SENSITIVE coming to the quarter pole and lost the led turning for home, angled out to the three path upper stretch, came again inside the eighth pole and won going away. TIME SENSITIVE tracked down the backside, made a bold four wide run mid turn, drove clear past the quarter pole, began to tire inside the furlong marker, failed late saving second place. SMARTY MOUTH unhurried early running mid track, rallied from the four path in upper stretch, loomed off of top pair mid stretch, needed more late. JOE KNOWS ALL lagged far off the pace, unhurried for six furlongs, gained momentum from upper stretch, finished with interest racing towards the inside. GAME APPEAL settled in the second flight, bid six wide top of the stretch, failed to sustain move and leveled off at the furlong marker. MIDWAY LANE hustled to the top, set a pressured pace racing in the three path to the half, began to give way past the quarter pole, finished spent. PLEASANT PACKY vied for the lead to the half running four wide, was all done leaving the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch finishing weary.
