KEG PARTY broke out brushing RON BURGUNDY at the start, angled to the rail running in mid pack, gained leaving the far turn, angled out three wide at the quarter pole and soon collared PUTALILEGLISHONIT, surged clear in upper stretch, was kept to task holding safe to the finish line. MEDIEVAL SWORD unhurried and trailed to the half along the rail, swung out mid turn, came four wide in upper stretch, surged late missing for the win in a good effort. PUTALILEGLISHONIT broke alertly grabbing the front end, set all the pace along the rail, battled gamely when headed by the winner, yielded stubbornly holding the show position. EL BUFADORA raced four wide into the first turn, tracked down the backside, gave chase form mid turn, lacked needed punch besting rest. R. J. SAYS settled in the second flight traveling between rivals, set down mid turn, swung out five wide mid stretch, mildly improved but failed to menace. RON BURGUNDY was brushed by KEG PARTY taking up briefly at the start, settled in the second flight, hard ridden traveling towards the inside from upper stretch, failed to threaten. DA DON raced up close to the leader from the start running two to three wide, held a menacing position at the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch, used up. SWEETSOUTHERNPITCH lacked speed racing towards the rear throughout, swung out five to six wide upper stretch under a drive, failed to factor. SIR SQUIRE rushed bid at the half to vie for the lead, was all done coming to the quarter pole, gave way in the lane. JOHORE was rank going into the first turn, stalked to the half, gave way on the turn finishing well beaten.
