Footnotes

FOXFIRE GIRL hustled from the gate, sat patient stalking the leader to mid turn, rallied along the rail near the quarter pole, drove clear in upper stretch, held sway late under steady encouragement. POETIC MANDATE broke in squeezing EVERYBODY RIDES, settled in mid pack, advanced mid turn along the rail, angled out top of the stretch, slowly gained on the winner in deep stretch, proved a willing second best. ROUGH THROWER rated to race in mid pack, rallied five wide entering the stretch, chased top pair but never menaced, saved show position late under a stiff drive. COMPACT JEANNE unhurried and raced towards the rear, advanced along the rail form mid turn, finished with interest vying for minor awards. STEALTHSPOTLIGHT was bumped leaving the gate losing an iron, set the pace racing at mid track, battled gamely to the quarter pole, had enough giving way in upper stretch. THEHOTTERTHEBETTOR lacked speed, raced towards the rear, mildly improved placing but never menaced. NOT HIS FAULT was briefly in tight shortly after the start, trailed to the half, offered little. EVERYBODY RIDES was squeezed at the break, rushed to race in good stalking position, gave way mid turn, well beaten. GOLD QUINTESSA rushed and pressed briefly, began to fade mid turn, stopped upper stretch and was eased to the finish.
