EXCLUSIVE ELUSIVE rushed hard going into the far turn, led mid turn traveling in the four path, was kept to pressure increasing advantage to the finish line. DEACON PAPA PETE tracked the winner from midway on the turn, gave chase under a drive entering the stretch, failed to menace but finished a willing second best. TIPSAW lacked speed and raced wide around the turn, hit best stride mid stretch and gave belated surge to get the show position in last jump. TAKE IT HOME DON stalked the winner to mid turn, saved ground throughout, began to tire mid stretch, was just edged out of third place on the wire. BLUELIGHTS N SIREN settled in the second flight, lost ground entering the stretch, failed to threaten. WHO'S THE ROCKSTAR raced up close to mid turn, began to fade inside the eighth pole. FAPPIE'S BOOKMORE raced evenly in mid pack, swung five wide into the stretch, lacked rally. GREGORY'S TRICK was soon outrun, angled to the rail early, showed little.
