**Footnotes**

LIVELY EXIT nicely rated down the backside, gained leaving the quarter pole, hit stride mid stretch, surged four wide to go past a pair of duelers in last jumps. BAND OF THIEVES sent hard, was involved in an extended duel throughout, lugged in on POLISH TRICK from mid stretch causing that rider to steady, was under sever left handed stick to the wire, was out nodded to just miss for the victory. POLISH TRICK sent hard, dueled inside of BAND OF THIEVES throughout, brushed the rail and had to steady briefly mid stretch when that rival lugged in, was out gamed coming to the wire, hard try. BOMBER BEAU raced in the second flight and saved ground on the turn, advanced from mid stretch, drifted out sharply in deep stretch crowding a tiring WHAT NOW WYNN coming to the wire. WHAT NOW WYNN hustled to race just off a speed duel, bid three wide to loom in upper stretch, was between rivals from mid stretch, was tiring late and pushed out by BOMBER BEAU coming to the wire. JAKE'S CONTENDER lacked speed, raced wide throughout, lost ground on the turn, did close the gap late. PANA CODE sent hard, pressed and vied while between foes down the backside, fell back leaving the quarter pole. BLACK SPRINGS lacked speed, angled towards the inside under a drive top of the lane, lacked rally, no threat. SPEEDSPOTS held a good stalking position to mid turn while four wide, faded from upper stretch. WOLF RUNNING was always outrun, never involved. A stewards inquiry into the stretch run was soon followed by the trainer of POLISH TRICK claiming a foul against the rider of BAND OF THIEVES for interference in the stretch run, after review, BAND OF THIEVES was disqualified and placed third for interference near the eighth pole.
