DESIRABLE DESI unhurried racing well off the pace and running towards the inside, angled out midway on the second turn, rallied five wide top of the stretch, drew even in deep stretch, inched up in last strides to gain a hard earned victory. FRISKY ROSIE rated early racing a little off the rail, rallied at the quarter pole, angled towards the inside for room turning for home, battled in three way duel upper stretch, edged clear momentarily mid stretch, went head to head with DESIRABLE DESI coming to the wire, lost nod and settled for second best in game effort. SARA'S HOT SHOT tracked the pace under a rating, gained four wide at the quarter pole, vied entering the stretch, could not keep pace inside the eighth pole, settled for show position. CHILE TEQUILA raced up close early on, bid three wide leaving the far turn, gained control at the quarter pole, dug in once headed top of the stretch, had nothing left by mid stretch giving way. SWEET EUPHORIA unhurried racing four wide down the backside, hard ridden from mid turn, raced six wide top of the lane, failed to factor. TIGHT MONEY forwardly placed running along the rail, chased under a drive from mid turn, lacked response and gave way upper stretch. FITZ 'N' STARTS hustled to the front, set the pace traveling a little off the rail, headed entering the far turn, battled to the quarter pole, stopped top of the stretch and was eased coming to the finish line.
