Footnotes

DUTY ROSTER raced evenly along the inside, rallied on rail upper stretch, surged clear gamely. IAM DIXIE pressed early wresting a short lead on the turn, dug in from the two path down the lane ceding grudgingly. CAN'T SPELL hustled outside, pressed five wide to upper stretch then weakened a bit late. LORD OF THUNDER hustled in pursuit, was extended at mid track upper stretch, wore down late. TRIPPIN SWEET slow early saved ground to upper stretch, proved no menace. CELTIC FIRE outrun early lost ground to upper stretch, finished evenly. DEAVER in tight at the break was never involved. FARLEYSHELONWHEELS was always outrun. HEZA HARLEY MAN pressed and chased through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. NEWBURY offered little.
