Footnotes

PRINCE OF BETHANY broke alertly and angled to the rail, pressed to the quarter pole, cleared for the lead entering the stretch, held HOMERSRUN safe to the finish under constant pressure. HOMERSRUN tracked the pace while off the rail, rallied four wide top of the stretch, loomed off the winner throughout the stretch run, could not get by proving second best in a hard effort. MY BOY ANGIE rated early racing in the second flight along the rail, swung four wide into the lane, finished willingly picking up third place. KILLIAN'S ADVICE raced up close traveling three wide, lacked rally when asked in upper stretch, tired in the drive besting rest. BISHFUL THINKING lacked speed running in the second flight, angled out four to five wide upper stretch, showed belated interest improving placing but never threatened. OLD FASHION MAN sent from the gate, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, lost control turning for home, faded from the furlong marker. AMERICAN SILENCE raced evenly throughout, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. MEDUSA flashed brief foot, made a steady fade from the quarter pole, raced five wide into the stretch. BIG HEARTED DON was off slowly and trailed down the backside, saved ground throughout, showed little. MEGA FUN was always outrun racing wide in a dull effort.
