ISLAND BREEZE stalked early on racing two to three wide, drew even turning for home and cleared when NEVERRGUWITRICHIE shied and took up entering the stretch, raced three to four wide for the stretch drive, held safe under pressure to the finish. COUNTRY SINGER raced mid pack down the backside, rallied to split foes on the turn, angled a bit wider upper stretch, was slowly getting to the winner late saving second place in a hard try. FONDA RONDA TWO settled in the second flight, advanced near the quarter pole, had to briefly steady when NEVERRGUWITRICHIE took up, angled back towards the rail late, surged and just missed second place in a game effort. POP UP settled in the second flight running four wide to the half, swung five wide top of the stretch, gave belated rally to finish with interest. NEVERRGUWITRICHIE set a well rated pace running along the rail, shied and took up entering the stretch causing brief confusion, regained stride mid stretch racing along the rail, was outfinished late vying for a minor award. THREEFORKS RIVER well placed early on, hard ridden coming five wide top of the lane, loomed briefly, failed to sustain bid and tired late. BEST REWARD raced up close to the leader along the rail, had to steady when NEVERRGUWITRICHIE checked entering the stretch, angled out for room, lacked needed rally. CATFISH HOOK trailed throughout racing along the inside, showed little.
