BUYIN' TIME pressed the early pace shaking clear on the turn, opened the margin under a hand ride in upper stretch then was put away nearing the wire winning in hand. SWEET AFTON raced evenly rushing hard to contention four deep on the turn, emerged off a loose BUYIN' TIME in upper stretch chasing that one home as a clear second best. BARELY A MEMORY pressed then chased BUYIN' TIME through the turn, dropped off in upper stretch finishing evenly along the inside to best others. DAWN OF THE SUN pressed early then chased while saving ground to upper stretch, wore down there near the rail. SCALD slow early lost ground to upper stretch remaining no factor. LADY CAROL never responded. GRAEME WAY was always outrun. RED PEPPER gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted in upper stretch.
