PETCH broke alertly, was confidently ridden around the bend dueling with BRAVE ART D'OR, put that rival away top of the lane, held safe lead and was ridden out to the finish. MANGO MANDATE rated and raced in the second flight, rallied five wide at the quarter pole, chased the winner from upper stretch, never threatened but finished a willing second best. MEGA WONDER settled in the second flight, launched rally from the quarter pole, traveled towards the inside in the stretch, finished with interest. PULPIT'S JET was not far off the pace, saved ground around the turn, was angled out five wide entering the stretch being hard ridden, needed more late. MUSIC FAN lagged far off the pace, came seven wide entering the lane, beat a couple of weary foes but was no factor. YOUNG LAD stalked early, rushed bid traveling four wide at the quarter pole, loomed entering the stretch, was angled over to the rail in upper stretch under an all out drive, faded late. BRAVE ART D'OR rushed hard, dueled with the winner to the quarter pole, dropped off entering the stretch, finished spent being well beaten.
