**Footnotes**

ONE TALL DRINK dropped back early going unhurried to the half, found stride maneuvering in advance along the inside through the far turn, emerged at the rail to take over in mid stretch holding sway late. SELYOU ROGERLOU raced evenly at mid pack, responded from the quarter bidding alongside TRY HARD GAL at the head of the lane, had good late action salvaging place. TRY HARD GAL sat close following USE IT OR LOSE IT through the backstretch, rallied to put a head in front taking the lead to upper stretch, overpowered by ONE TALL DRINK outside the eighth pole would wear down on the inside late. KENTUCKY MERRY off slowly was outrun through the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch came on to pass tired ones. BENS BABE bumped at the break was hustled off the pace, made a minor move on the far turn remaining no threat. POCKIE MAY raced evenly at mid pack, made a wide move on the far turn flattening out in upper stretch. MS. READINESS lost ground following USE IT OR LOSE IT five wide to the half, rallied dueling abreast TRY HARD GAL on the far turn folding up at the top of the lane. USE IT OR LOSE IT sent clear then measured on a soft pace, shortened stride giving way under the whip on the far turn. KAT'S DREAM stalked for half giving way on the far turn. SHARON'S CHOICE was done early.
