Footnotes

THIS CATS ON FIRE dueled with PRIMARY KATE to mid turn, drew off entering the stretch, continued to widen and won easily being ridden out. BELLARIFFIC tracked around the bend, bid three wide chasing the winner entering the stretch, failed to threaten in the lane digging in late saving second place. DEVILSFROSTREPORT unhurried early trailing around the turn racing along the rail, angled a bit in upper stretch, was under left handed stick making a mild bid, needed a bit more late missing second place. AWESOMEINMOONLIGHT broke outward, raced wide throughout, improved placing but failed to menace. J Z'S REVENGE was urged from the gate, stalked then chased from the quarter pole, tired in the lane never factoring. PRIMARY KATE sent from the gate, dueled with the winner to mid turn, was all done and gave way in upper stretch. RACE ROCKET raced evenly traveling three to four wide around the turn, gave way top of the stretch finishing well beaten.
