Footnotes

HANDSOME BRUNO was taken in hand and trailed for six furlongs, angled to the four path upper stretch, waited briefly for room mid stretch, surged between foes in deep stretch, got up under strong left handed stick in last jumps. SMILAN IN MILAN led then pressed for the lead racing three wide, inched clear in deep stretch racing between foes, was out noddled in last jumps missing in a very determined effort. LETTHEBIGTIMESROLL tracked a hot pace for six furlongs, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, vied in a four way battle mid stretch and put a head in front briefly, fought hard to the wire but was outgamed in last strides. CLEVER PERFORMANCE was forwardly placed racing mid track, came four wide racing abreast rivals in upper stretch, loomed from the eighth pole, was outfinished late needing more. SOUTHERN RAINBOW raced four wide into the first turn, settled mid pack under a rating, advanced along the rail turning for home, loomed off of duelers at the eighth pole, hung late needing more. AVOID was hustled early, gained control going to the half setting a rapid pace, pressured around the bend, running in the two path, headed from both sides top of the lane, shortened stride mid stretch. BUILT TO PRECISION lacked speed traveling mid track, failed to respond when roused, never threatened.
