CHOOSE HONOUR broke alertly setting the pace clinging to a slim lead through the turn, shook off SUPREME MAKE to clear in upper stretch holding firm late in the two path. SUPREME MAKER hustled out chased early then pressed the leader hard on the turn, turned away in upper stretch was weakening late holding up for place in the four path. BEL AIR BABE chased early then dropped off the leaders on the turn, came three wide between horses down the lane regrouping to finish well. NUVO raced evenly through the turn, came five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. SECRET INFORMATION veered out a bit leaving the gate, raced second flight angling six wide in upper stretch. MONSTER SWEETPEA broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, weakened along the rail in upper stretch. PENCIL PUSHER slow early swung out seven wide in upper stretch finding little there. R S JOY brushed at the break was always outrun. MARTINI STREET faded on the turn. MIND THE LAW was always outrun racing eight wide through the lane.
