Footnotes

MOTEGA stalked pace around the bend, came four wide entering the stretch, headed a pair of duelers mid stretch, drew off late to win going away under steady handling. MAMOOGUSKA pressed for the early lead, angled outside of ONE HOT PHILLY at the quarter pole, drew even upper stretch, vied in a three way battle mid stretch, was no match for the winner but proved a game second best. BERYOZKA settled in mid pack, bid three to four wide from upper stretch, received strong left handed stick in the drive, finished willingly gaining third place. AUTIE lacked speed racing mid track, swung five wide entering the stretch, found best stride too late to finish with interest. ONE HOT PHILLY was hard used clearing for the lead, angled to the rail setting a pressured pace, battled to mid stretch, stopped a sixteenth out finishing spent. BLAST IN A GLASS settled mid pack running along the rail, angled out in upper stretch, failed to respond, no threat. ZARCH was bumped by DIAMOND EXCHANGE leaving the gate, trailed throughout, showed little. DIAMOND EXCHANGE broke in bumping ZARCH, raced along the rail throughout, faded from upper stretch.
