SOY SAUCE well rated rallied to contention on the far turn wresting the lead in the four path upper stretch angling inside while widening late. LIGHT SLEEPER unhurried early circled out while moving up on the far turn, pressed abreast rivals in the six path upper stretch proving no match for SOY SAUCE late. GO GONE GIRL prompted the pace through the backside shaking clear on the far turn, hooked from the outside in upper stretch would wear down in the three path. CONGRUENT slow early stayed back through the far turn, swung out to mid track in upper stretch finished evenly. EMILY SUN SHINE tracked the pace moving evenly through the backside, roused on the far turn would flatten under asking. CLIFFY'S DYNAGIRL gave early retreat. GUILTY TREASURES hustled to the front pressed a short lead through the backside then wilted on the far turn. CRYPTOLOGIST ridden along while dropping far back early labored .
