AVOID broke alertly pressing the pace wresting the lead on the turn, shook clear in upper stretch drawing out in the four path. COTTON TOP PHIL stalked the pace pressing to challenge on the turn, no match for the winner down the lane held well as second best. SARGE'S off slowly trailed through the turn, came six wide in upper stretch mustering a mild late rally. MIG ALLEY went evenly off the pace, angled five wide in upper stretch gaining late position. FASTER THAN FLASH slow early was outrun through the turn, gave a mild move in upper stretch then hung late. KING THOU ART broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. CHALLENGER chased early then wore down into upper stretch. SHY LOVER showed early speed then gave way to upper stretch. MADE THE STEAL folded up on the turn.
