Footnotes

SHAMELESS RISK rated from the start, asked mid turn, swung five wide gaining momentum entering the stretch, dueled outside of JEROBOAM from mid stretch, slowly edged up under a stiff drive in last jumps. JEROBOAM quickly showed in front, set the pace traveling along the rail, fought hard when headed by the winner, yielded grudgingly in a hard effort. UNO WAY CALLE stalked early on saving ground, angled three wide top of the lane, loomed from upper stretch, moved back to the rail inside the eighth pole, leveled off needing more. TEXAS HOLLADAY settled in the mid pack, raced inside throughout, mildly improved placing but never menaced. MEGONE raced in the second flight, came five wide into the lane under a drive, failed to respond lacking surge. DOWNONMAINSTREET hustled early and tracked to the quarter pole, began to tire in upper stretch, no threat. LATENIGHTOFFICER lacked speed, raced wide around the turn, offered little. DANCE FOR MILITARY pressed for the early lead, started to fade leaving the quarter pole, gave way upper stretch finishing spent. CERRADOR broke rank, struggled in the opening strides, was eased, rider dismounted and was vanned off.
