WON O WON stalked close up pressing to put a head in front in the four path upper stretch, digging in near mid track would hold under full extension. SOLUTIONFINDERS tracked close up to the far turn, pressed there angling six wide in upper stretch, bid gamely in the closing yards. STORMY DUDE broke alertly setting the pace nursing a short lead to the far turn, dueling into upper stretch battled outside pressure in the three path ceding grudgingly late. ASHORE stalked close up while saving ground, in tight was forced to steady near the quarter pole, regrouped along the rail in upper stretch bidding gamely to the end. SURF CAST slow early angled four and five wide down the lane finishing well. WILLIAM'S KITTEN raced a step slow in the four and five path to the far turn, moved out seven wide in upper stretch lacked needed late surge. CATRILLION stalked the pace staying close through the far turn, extending in the two path upper stretch came up short late. DEAD MONEY played no factor. PAUL BUNYAN was always outrun.
