Footnotes

CUT AND SHOOT broke sharply engaging PAINTER'S CREEK on pace dueling abreast rival through the turn, shook clear into upper stretch drawing off in drive along the inside. STOIC ENDEAVOUR hustled along chasing dueling pacesetters through the turn, bid four wide in upper stretch moving past PAINTER'S CREEK late to finish a clear second best. PAINTER'S CREEK hustled out moved inside of CUT AND SHOOT as the pair carried the pace through the turn, ceded to rival in upper stretch then wore down the final sixteenth. SARIBINDA slow early was outrun through the turn swinging seven wide into upper stretch, mustered enough there to outbid others. A K'S QUEST raced evenly angling to mid track in upper stretch, had no surge in drive. DEPUTY EXPRESS stumbled at the break playing no factor after. JENKINS' FERRY raced evenly to mid turn then flattened out six wide in upper stretch. A KING'S SMILE was always outrun. RAYWICK offered little.
